Some individuals may be covered by private dental insurance, either on its own or as a supplement to certain programs.

Certain groups of people have access to targeted programs: Quebec Oral Health Care and Daily Oral Hygiene Program in CHSLDs, Pediatric Oncology Oral Health Care Program, Oral Radiation Oncology Program, Oral Health Care Program for Rare Diseases, Medically Required Dental Care Program, and the Dental Sealants Program in elementary and secondary schools.

Certain oral surgery treatments are covered for all holders of a valid RAMQ card when performed in a hospital setting. Examinations, anesthesia (local or general), and X-rays associated with the surgery are also covered.
Examples: removal of a cyst or tumor, drainage of an abscess, reduction of a fracture, repair of soft tissue tears (cheek, tongue, palate), treatment of osteitis, treatment of the temporomandibular joint, treatment of the salivary glands, etc.
